Based on Edward Lear's poem, with originally composed music.

#### Site Requirements:

Performance area: We play to a crowd gathered in a semicircle show (grass, street or woodland)

#### Audience Size: 200

1 flat performance space 4 metres x 4 metres minimum, with additional viewing room for the audience to sit in a semicircle. Where possible we prefer to play with the sun in performers faces, with the sun behind the audience.

#### Murmuration will provide:

- 2 performers are on tour with the show
- Costumes & Masks
- Props
- Large rope for audience space definition

#### Shows:

- 3 x 30 minute circle shows / day including post show photos and walkabout.
- Get in 1 hour / Get out 30 minutes. Can move off the pitch quickly for other acts to go on the same site.
- All show times to be within a 7 hour window

#### Host Festival to provide:

#### Sound:

- Sufficient PA system suitable for all weather
- Sound technician
- 2 x headworn radio mics (one black, one cream)
- Belt packs and mic muffles with spare muffles
- Wireless guitar jack input (we will bring our acoustic guitar with a pick up and quarter inch jack output)
- Technician to raise and lower the sound (one cue on, one off) and check levels throughout the show.
- Steward to support the audience / check props are returned / support performers with local area.

Please note; we do not tour with a technician so this needs to be provided.

#### **Dressing Room:**

- Show Days: dry, warm, safe, secure access to a dressing room / marguee. Hidden from audience sightlines. Plus 2 x chairs, bin bags, drinking water, mirror, 1x table and clothes rail / hooks.
- Toilet available on show days with sanitary provision, near the performance area, hidden from audience sightlines.

#### Catering:

- Hot drinks/water, plus 2 x substantial hot meals per performer on each show day or per diems.
- Dietary requirements to be confirmed.
- Our performers tour with their own reusable water bottles, so ideally water is not from a plastic bottle.
